



Reflection - Matthew 4:12-23

Something in Jesus attracted a group to follow him. They must have known of him already, had been looking forward to meeting him, and now were ready to leave John the Baptist and follow him. Maybe they saw him as the one they admired in how he dealt with people with compassion and dignity; maybe his words and vision about a better world and the coming of God's kingdom drew them; maybe just his personality and his offer of friendship.
