Pope Francis' Reflection on the feast of Epiphany

'If we want to find Jesus, we have to overcome our fear of taking risks, our self-satisfaction and our indolent refusal to ask anything more of life', Francis said. **'We need to take risks simply to meet a Child'**.

The Three Wise Men, also traditionally called the Magi, were the only ones who saw the star leading the way to the manger, the pope said, because **they were among the few people who raised their eyes to the heavens**.

The Magi **'talk little and journey much'**, and once they arrive at the manger they gave gifts, imitating Jesus who came to the world to offer His life. 'To give freely, for the Lord's sake, without expecting anything in return: this is the sure sign that we have found Jesus', the pope said. 'To do good without counting the cost, even when unasked, even when you gain nothing thereby, even if it is unpleasant. That is what God wants'.
